



INTERNAL RULES OF THE POOL

Access to the swimming pool is free and strictly reserved for campsite customers who must comply with the internal regulations.

1 – Opening

The campsite swimming pool is open

Hours: 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

The Management reserves the right to modify schedules or close the swimming pool, particularly for technical, hygiene or safety reasons.

2 – Clothes and behavior of users

Swimsuit is obligatory.

[Wearing long shorts, Bermuda shorts and T-shirts in the water is prohibited.]

[Boxer shorts are accepted.]

Users must remain properly and decently dressed.

Any act or behavior likely to undermine decency, good morals, the tranquility of bathers, good order and cleanliness of the establishment is strictly prohibited. He will be sanctioned by immediate dismissal from the pool.

It is prohibited to operate radio devices, recorders or CD players and to take photographs without the consent of the persons concerned.

3 - Hygiene

Animals are strictly prohibited within the pool area.

Showering, as well as going through the footbaths, are obligatory when entering and leaving the pool.

It is forbidden to enter with shoes on your feet. Place them in the lockers for this purpose in the entrance.

Access to the pools is prohibited to people suffering from illnesses whose external effects may cause discomfort or contagion to others, as well as to people in a state of obvious uncleanliness.

It is forbidden to eat, drink, smoke, chew gum, spit and throw trash in the pool area; trash cans are reserved for this purpose.

Only young children who are “clean” or equipped with special diapers for swimming are allowed to swim.

Each bather will ensure order and cleanliness within the pool area.

4 – Accountability and Oversight

Access to the swimming pool is free and strictly reserved for campsite customers who must comply with the internal regulations.

The swimming pool is not supervised.

Minors must be accompanied by their parents who are responsible for their sole supervision.

The management cannot under any circumstances be held responsible in the event of an accident.

5 – Security

For their own safety, pool users are asked to comply with the internal regulations.

It's forbidden :

- to annoy users with noisy, dangerous or immoral games or acts;
- to push or throw people parking on the beaches into the water;
- to run, shout, dive, throw water;
- to simulate drowning;
- play ball on the beaches;
- to enter prohibited areas indicated by sign or placard;
- use floating devices and lifebuoys;
- bathe with your body coated in solar oil
- to climb fences and separations of any kind;

6 – Respect for facilities

It is prohibited to damage the fixtures and fittings. Any damage or damage will be repaired at the expense of the offenders.

7 – Sanctions

Violators of these provisions may be excluded from the swimming pool at any time by staff.

8 – Items found

The campsite is not insured against the loss or theft of jewelry, valuables or cash, even if given to staff. Users are advised not to bring any valuable items. Objects found must be returned and/or claimed at the campsite reception.
